

Block Party Contest

HOW TO ENTER

1. Free entry forms are available at rmhcna.org/coupons Entry forms are available from June 1, 2017 to June 24, 2017, while supplies last. No purchase necessary. Limit one entry form per person. 2. The Contest is open to all residents of Canada (excluding residents of Quebec) except any person who was employed at any time after January 1, 2017 by McDonald's Restaurants of Canada Limited ("McDonald's") or by McDonald's parent, subsidiaries, franchisees, associated companies or its advertising and promotional agencies, or any person who was employed by Ronald McDonald House Charities® Northern Alberta or by their respective parent, subsidiaries, associated companies and its advertising and promotional agencies at any time after January 1, 2017, and the immediate family (defined as spouse, child, sister, brother, father and mother), whether actual or purported, of any such ineligible person and any person living in the same residence, whether related or not, as any such ineligible person. A person who is eligible as defined above is referred to in these Official Rules as an "eligible entrant". 3. To enter the Contest, legibly complete the entry form, and deposit your completed entry form in the entry form box located at the Block Party June 25, 2017, 7726-107st between 11-5 p.m. On or about 11 a.m.-5 p.m. on June 25, 2017 at the RMHCNA Block Party located at 7726- 107st, the Block Party representative judging the Contest (the "judge") will draw, at random, one completed entry form, from all completed entry forms deposited by eligible entrants at the Block Party entry form box up to the Contest Closing Date. The judge also will draw sequentially, at random, two additional completed entry forms between 11 a.m.-5p.m., from all completed entry forms deposited by eligible entrants in the entry form box up to the Contest Closing Date, for potential use in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 10 of the "General" section of these Official Rules. 2. The chances of winning the prize depend upon the number of completed entry forms deposited by eligible entrants at the Block Party entry form box up to the Contest Closing Date. Three different draws awarding a \$50 McDonald's Restaurants Gift Card per draw.

GENERAL RULES

1. Each entrant agrees to abide by these Official Rules and the decision of the McDonald's representative judging the Contest. 2. All entry forms become the property of McDonald's and none will be returned. 3. The, McDonald's, Ronald McDonald House Charities Northern Alberta or any of their respective franchisees, parent, associated companies, advertising or promotional agencies reserve the right to use the winner's name, address (town/city and Province), and/or voice, photograph, videotape, or any likeness for advertising or publicity purposes in any medium, including the Internet, and to the use of statements made by or attributed to the winner relating to the Contest, without further notice, approval or compensation. 4.
